





Sir Timothy Berners-Lee



Sir Timothy Berners-Lee is a famous computer scientist. He was born on 8 June 1955 in London, England. In his family there were two computer scientists: his father and mother.

Berners-Lee went to Oxford University and got a degree in physics in 1976. He even made a computer out of an old TV when he was at university. He then worked in different companies as an engineer, and in 1980 he started working at CERN.

There, in 1990, he created the World Wide Web (WWW). His goal was to create a way for scientists in universities around the world to share information with each other. Then, in 1993, the World Wide Web became available to all, and today it is part of our daily lives. Berners-Lee is still very important in the IT world.
