Subject	used to	Verb
I / You / He / She / It / We / They	used to	play

Example: I **used to** play football.

✗ Negative

Subject	didn't	use to	Verb
I / You / He / She / It / We / They	didn't	use to	play

Example: She **didn't use to** like smartphones.
