Animals are amazing **creatures**. Some animals, like cats, have soft **fur** and long **whiskers** that help them feel things in the dark. Cats like to **sneak up** slowly on their **prey**. Dogs are very **loyal** — they always stay with their owners. You can train a dog to **fetch a stick**, **shake hands** and even **jump through hoops on command**. Some police dogs help officers **rescue** people and **fight crime**. If you want a pet, you should **adopt** one from your **local shelter** — many animals there would **starve** without a loving home. Crows are very intelligent birds. They use **twigs** as tools to **crack nuts**. Ants work very hard — they **dig** tunnels and **push** food **underground**. **Lizards** move **slowly** and some carry **poison**. Hedgehogs **curl into a ball** when they feel scared. It is important to **feed** animals regularly. **If so**, they will stay healthy and happy **after** each meal. **Male** and **female** animals both need food, care and shelter. Be **careful** — always handle animals **slowly** and gently!
