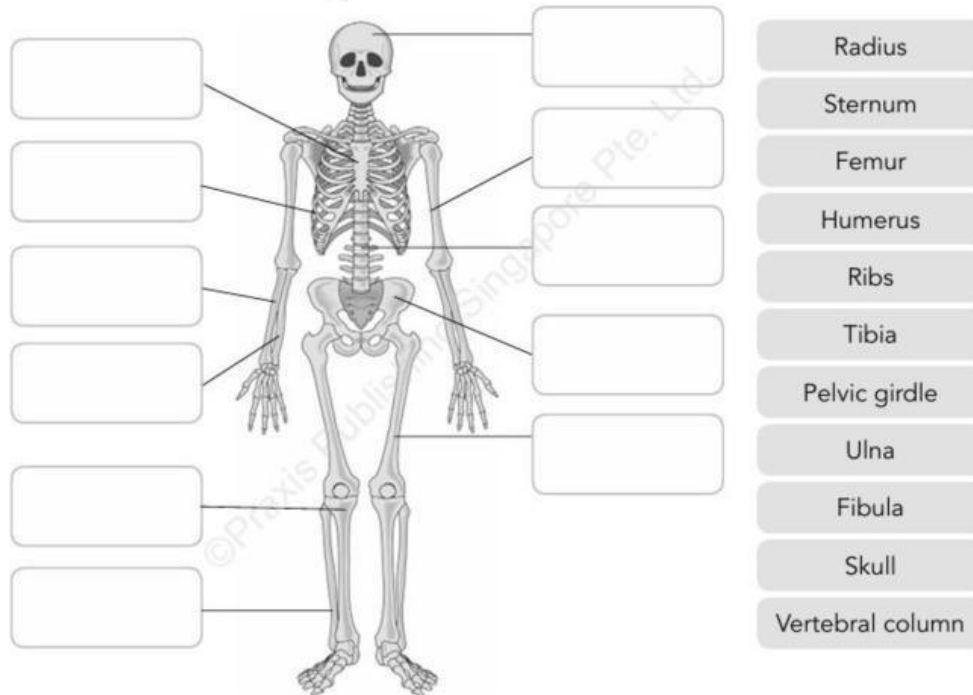

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2. The figure shows the human skeletal system.

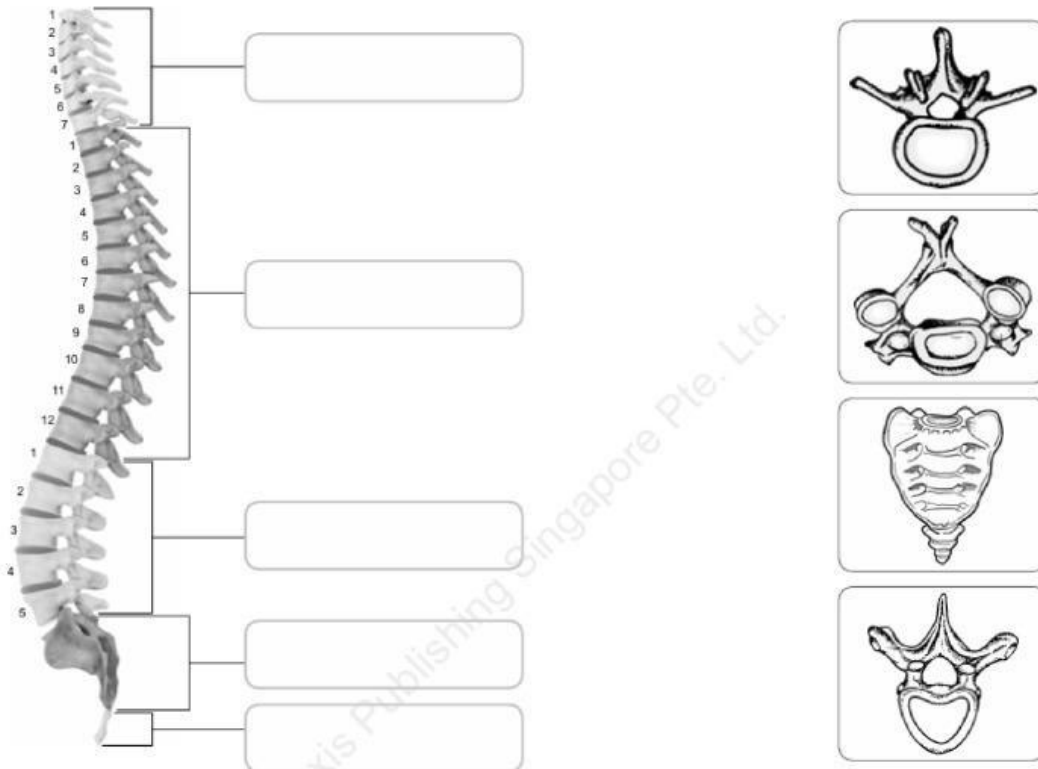


3. Tick (✓) the correct statements and cross (X) the incorrect statements about the human skeleton.

- (a) The axial skeleton forms the central framework of the body.
- (b) The human skull is composed of 22 bones, including 8 cranial bones and 14 facial bones.
- (c) Sutures are immovable joints that connect the bones of the skull, providing stability and protection for the brain.
- (d) The cranium is a single bone that encases the brain and forms the structure of the face.
- (e) The rib cage consists of 12 pairs of ribs that are attached to the thoracic vertebrae and the sternum.
- (f) The vertebral column is composed of a single continuous bone that runs from the base of the skull to the pelvis.
- (g) All vertebrae in the vertebral column are identical in size and shape.
- (h) The appendicular skeleton consists only of the bones in the hands and feet.
