But they aren't digging holes today. They're performing a **ballet**. Now the dancing has finished, and I'm watching a juggler. She's throwing fire sticks high up into the air. Suddenly she falls onto the ground. Is she going to drop the fire sticks? No, she catches them all, and the audience laughs and claps loudly.



Every July, for five days, street performers from all around the world come to Prague to take part in Behind the Door—the Prague Street Theater Festival. There are more than forty different shows at the festival, including huge puppets, clowns, acrobats, musicians, and people who walk on **stilts**. Perhaps you'd like to watch a movie? You can visit a yurt—a traditional tent—and watch Piotr and Jacek. Piotr is an actor, and Jacek is a musician. Together, they perform a movie story, with **mime**, music, and sounds but no words.
