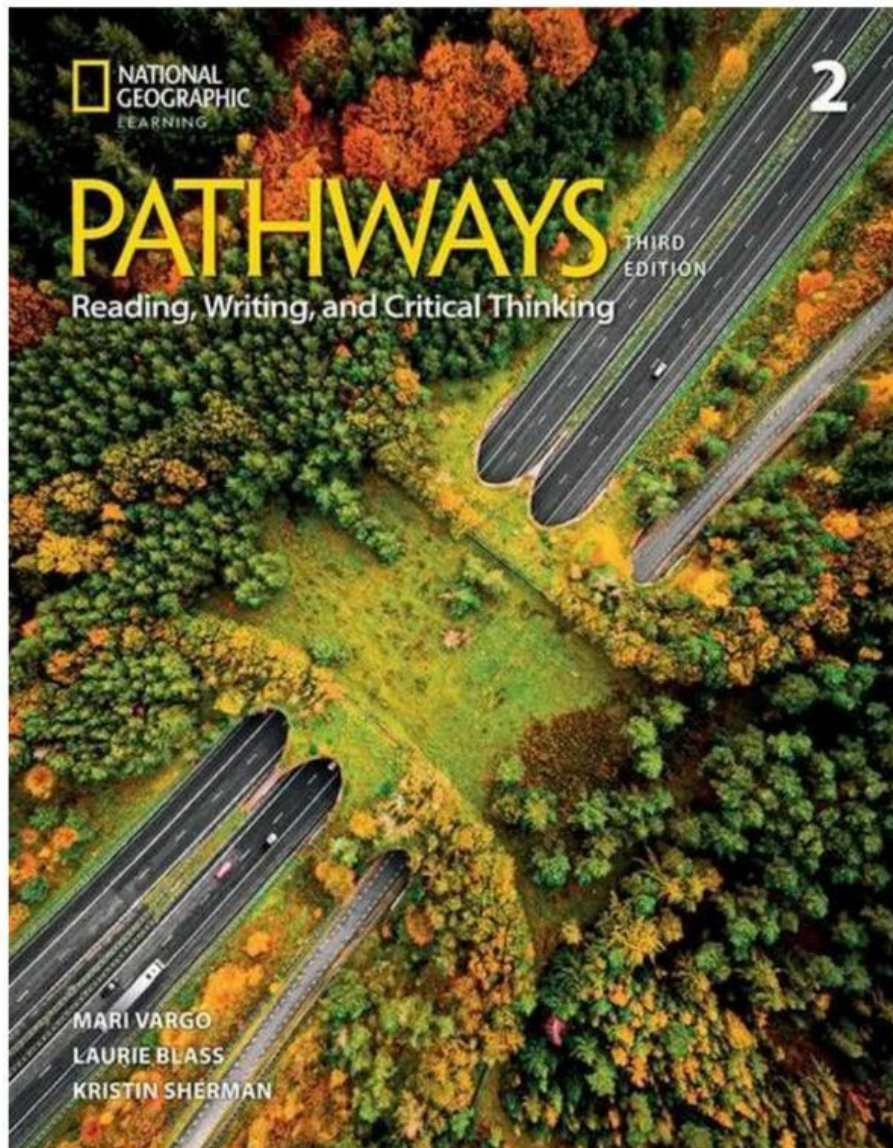

creative	adj	able to make new ideas/things
design	n/v	plan or style; to create/plan how something will look/work
disease	n	illness
dramatically	adv	greatly/suddenly/noticeably
efficient	adj	working well without wasting time/energy
effort	n	hard work; attempt
electricity	n	electric power/energy
equipment	n	tools/machines needed for a task
eventually	adv	in the end; after some time
innovation	n	a new idea/method/product
install	v	to put equipment in place so it can be used

prevention	n	stopping something bad from happening
rural	adj	relating to the countryside (not the city)
store	v/n	(v) to keep/save; (n) a shop
struggle	v/n	to fight/have difficulty; a difficult effort
valuable	adj	worth a lot; very useful/important
affordable	adj	not too expensive
comfortable	adj	pleasant; physically at ease
incredible	adj	very surprising/amazing; hard to believe
possible	adj	able to happen/be done

accepting	adj	welcoming/positive about someone or something
anger	n	a strong feeling of being mad
brand	n/v	(n) a company name/product line; (v) to mark or promote as a brand
common	adj	usual; happening often
consumer	n	a person who buys/uses goods and services
critic	n	a person who judges/reviews (films, music, etc.)
deserve	v	to be worthy of (reward/punishment, etc.)
devoted	adj	very loyal and committed
dominate	v	to control or be stronger/more important than others
donate	v	to give (money/items) to help others
entertainment	n	shows/activities that amuse people
festival	n	a public celebration or series of events
ignore	v	to not pay attention to; to refuse to consider
interview	n/v	(n) a formal conversation with questions; (v) to ask questions formally

release	n/v	(n) making something available; (v) to let go/publish/issue
rush	n/v	(n) a busy hurry; (v) to move/do something quickly
society	n	people in general; a community with shared laws/culture
sold-out	adj	completely sold; no tickets/items left
widely	adv	by many people; in many places
actor	n	a person who performs in films/plays
designer	n	a person who designs clothes/products/graphics, etc.
driver	n	a person who drives a vehicle
singer	n	a person who sings
