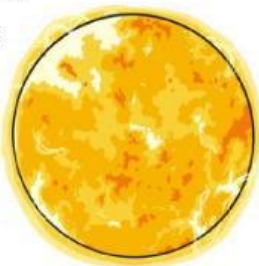
Activity 1 Needs of Plants

All plants need these things to grow and keep living.

Sun

Plants need sunlight to help them make their own food and grow well.

Some plants have big leaves to absorb lots of light. Some plants need bright light to grow and some can live in shadows with less light.



Water

Plants need water to survive just like us! Water helps plants to carry nutrients from the soil to different parts of the plant. Some plants need a lot and some only need a little. Plants absorb water through their roots and a little bit through their leaves.



Air

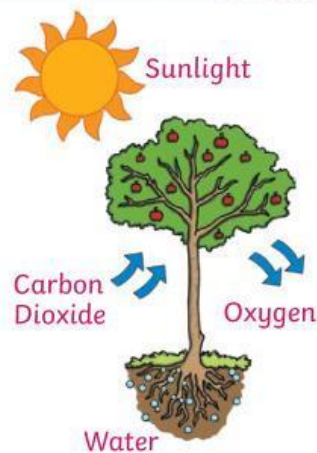
Plants take in gases from the air. Carbon dioxide and oxygen are needed by plants.

They need carbon dioxide to make their own food. Humans take in oxygen and let out carbon dioxide, but plants are different - they take in carbon dioxide and give out oxygen.



Food

Plants also need food. They make their own food using water, sunlight and a gas from the air-this is called photosynthesis (say fow·tow·sin·thuh·suhs).

Soil

Healthy soil provides plants with nutrients. Roots can grow in soil. Healthy soil is important for plant growth.



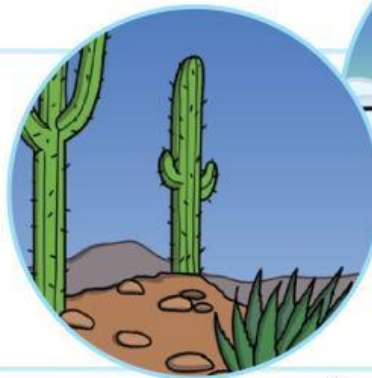
Space

Plants need enough room to grow properly.



Temperature

Different plants grow well in different temperatures. Usually, when plants get too hot or too cold they will die.

What happens if plants don't get what they need? If plants don't get the right amount of what they need, they won't grow well or won't grow at all. Plants need sun, water, air, food, soil, space and the right temperature, then they can survive.

What do plants need to survive?

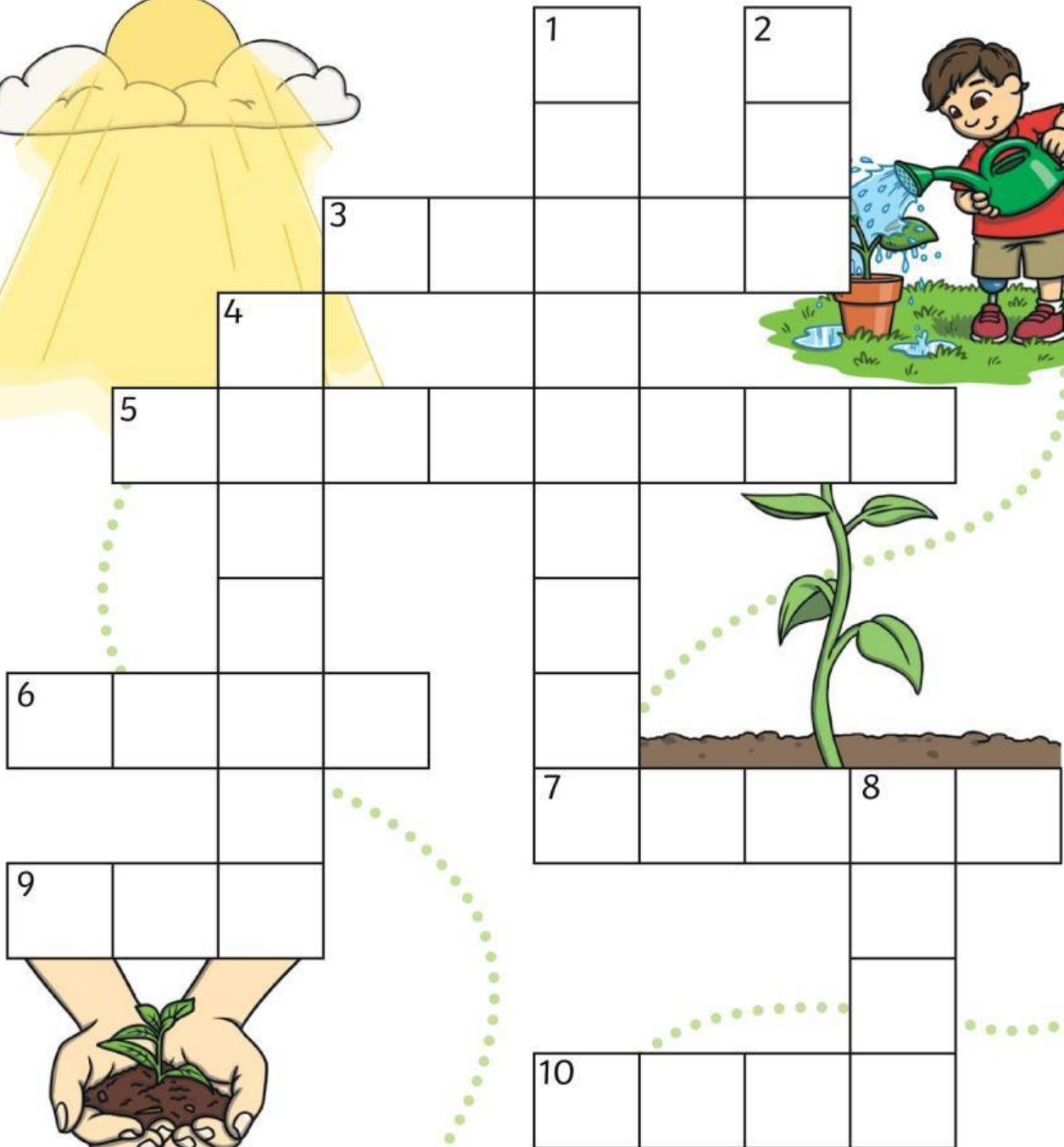
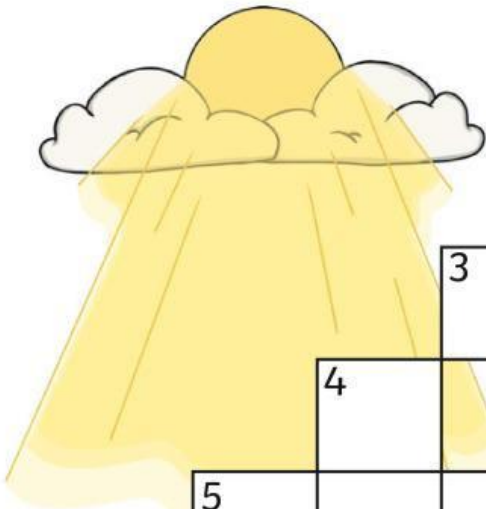

Sun and water, sun and water.

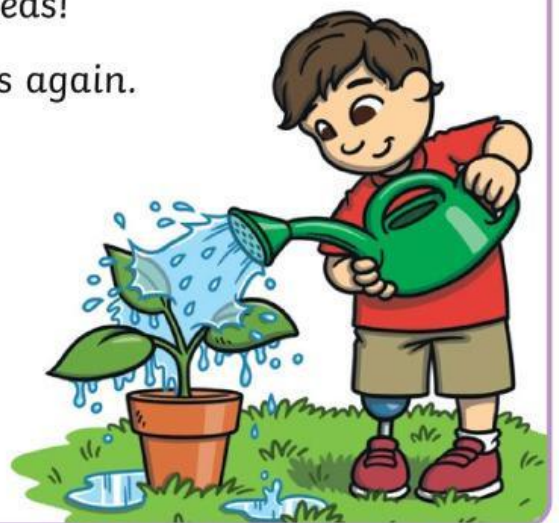
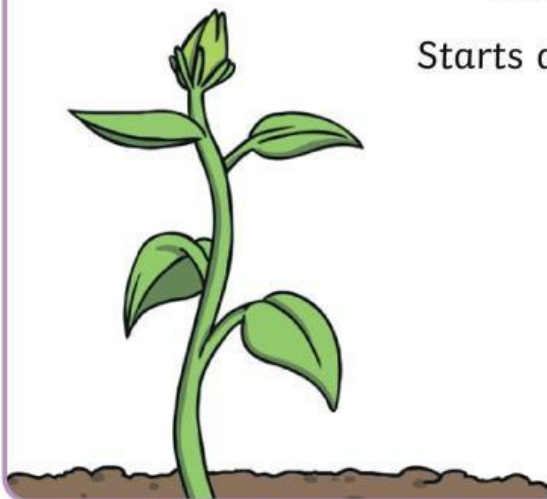

Plants get the water they need from rivers, oceans, creeks, underground water, melted snow, rain or humidity in the air.



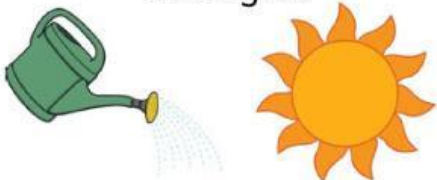
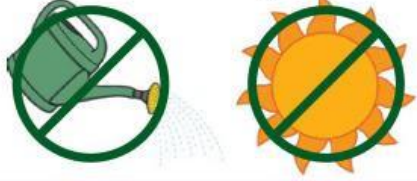


Activity 7 Science Activity
