Words you need...



- ▶ **to arrive** to get to a place
- ▶ **to book (something)** to arrange to do something or have something such as tickets or a hotel room
- ▶ **to check in** to go to a place at an airport where you show your ticket to someone before you travel
- ▶ **a flight** a journey in an aircraft
- ▶ **to fly (somewhere)** to go on a journey in an aircraft
- ▶ **to get back** to return to your home at the end of a journey
- ▶ **a journey** a period of time when you travel from one place to another
- ▶ **to leave (somewhere)** to go away from a place
- ▶ **to stay (somewhere)** to live somewhere such as a hotel when you are away from home
- ▶ **a visa** an official document that allows you to enter a country

▶ **a passport**



▶ **a ticket**

UK / US  

In UK English, the word **holiday** is used. In US English the word **vacation** is used.

Using prepositions to talk about travel



After **go** and **get**, we use **to** before a place name or a building:

- ▶ *I'm going to Ecuador/the airport.*
- ▶ *We got to Istanbul/the station at three.*

After **arrive**, we use **in** before a place name, and **at** before a building:

- ▶ *We arrived in Mexico/Denver at 3 p.m.*
- ▶ *We arrived at the station/the airport at nine.*
