

# 17/ Getting around

## Words you need...



- ▶ **a car park** a place where you can leave your car
- ▶ **to change** to get off one train, bus, etc. and get onto another
- ▶ **direct** going straight from one place to another
- ▶ **a driver** someone who drives a vehicle
- ▶ **to get off (something)** to leave a bus, train, etc.
- ▶ **to get on (something)** to go onto a bus, train, etc.
- ▶ **to park (your car)** to stop your car and leave it somewhere
- ▶ **a passenger** someone who is travelling in a car but is not the driver
- ▶ **a route** the roads or paths you go on to get from one place to another
- ▶ **a seat** the thing you sit on in a bus, train, etc.
- ▶ **a seat belt** a strap that goes across your body when you are in a car, aircraft, etc.
- ▶ **traffic** the cars and other vehicles that are on a road

### Exercise 1

Miriam likes to travel by train, while Guy prefers to drive. Read the statements. Write M after the ones you think Miriam made, and G after the ones you think Guy made.

- 1 When you are a passenger, you have time to read or listen to music. M
- 2 You can usually park close to the place where you are going.
- 3 Trains usually take the most direct route, so they are quick.
- 4 You have to pay a lot to leave your car in a car park.
- 5 Drivers can make all their own decisions about what time to leave, who to travel with – everything!
- 6 When you get off the train, it may still be a long way to the place where you are going.
