

Putting words together...



- ▶ A **calm sea** is when the water is flat, because there is not much wind, and a **rough sea** is when there are big waves.
- ▶ To talk about the way the water in a river moves, we say a **river flows**.
- ▶ **The sun rises** when it comes up in the morning, and **the sun sets** when it goes down at night.
- ▶ When a piece of land goes up quickly we talk about a **steep slope** and when it goes up slowly, we say a **gentle slope**.
- ▶ We say that people **climb a hill** or **climb a mountain** when they go up it.
