

Putting words together...



- If people or things **damage the environment**, they cause harm to it, and if they try to **protect the environment**, they try to make sure it is not harmed. We can also say that people try to **save the planet**.
- If people **save energy**, they use less of it, and if they **reduce pollution**, they cause levels of it to fall. If they **waste energy**, they use more than they need to.
- **The temperature of something** is how hot or cold it is, and if **the temperature rises**, it gets hotter.
- We say that **ice melts** when it turns into water, and this can **make sea levels rise**.
