I. GRAMMAR: PAST SIMPLE PASSIVE

Nội dung	Past Simple Passive (Câu bị động ở thì quá khứ đơn)	
Định nghĩa	Câu bị động ở thì quá khứ đơn dùng để nói về một hành động đã xảy ra và kết thúc trong quá khứ, trong đó chủ ngữ là người hoặc vật nhận tác động của hành động.	
Cách dùng	- Nhấn mạnh hành động hoặc kết quả - Không biết người thực hiện hành động - Người thực hiện không quan trọng hoặc đã quá rõ - Nói về các sự kiện, công trình hoặc phát minh trong quá khứ	
Công thức	(+) S + was/were + V3/ed + (by + O).	Eg: The museum was opened in 1995.
	(-) S + was/were not + V3/ed + (by + O)	Eg: The door was not locked last night.
	(?) Was/Were + S + V3/ed + (by + O)? → Yes, S + was/were → No, S + was/were + not	Eg: Was the letter sent yesterday? → Yes, it was. → No, it wasn't/was not.
	(Wh?) Wh-word + was/were + S + V3/ed?	When was the school built ?

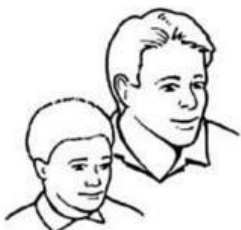
Sheila has decided to take her mother to the cinema for her birthday. They both like love stories that have happy endings.
