- If you say that someone **does** some **cooking**, you mean that they prepare some food.
- When you **put the kettle on**, you turn it on to make the water in the kettle hot.
- You **put** food **in** an oven to cook and you **take it out** of an oven when it is cooked.
- If you **wash up** or **do the dishes**, you clean plates, bowls, knives, etc. in water, and if you **dry up**, you make them dry using a piece of cloth. (Dishes in this content means plates, bowls, pans, etc. that need washing.)
