A. Grammar Box

We use some in affirmative (+) sentences. 	Pattern	Examples
	There is some + uncountable noun.	- There are some books on the desk. - There are some pencils in the bag.
	There are some + plural countable nouns.	- There is some paper on the table. - There is some water in the cup.

We use any in negative (-) sentences. 	Pattern	Examples
	There isn't any + uncountable noun.	- There aren't any rulers under the desk. - There aren't any posters on the wall.
	There aren't any + plural countable nouns.	- There isn't any paper in the bag. - There isn't any water in the bottle.

We use any in questions (?). 	Pattern	Examples
	Is there any + uncountable noun?	- Are there any computers in the classroom? - Are there any crayons in the bag?
	Are there any + plural countable nouns?	- Is there any paper on the teacher's desk? - Is there any water in the cup?
