Words you need...



- ▶ **a code** a group of numbers that are used at the start of the telephone numbers in a particular country or area
- ▶ **an international call** a telephone call that you make to another country
- ▶ **a local call** a telephone call that you make to someone who lives in the same town or area as you
- ▶ **a message** a piece of spoken or written information that one person gives or sends to another
- ▶ **to post something** (UK)/**to mail something** (US) to send a letter or parcel to someone
- ▶ **a reply** an answer that you say or write
- ▶ **to reply** to say or write something as an answer
- ▶ **a text** a message that you send from one mobile (UK)/cell (US) phone to another
- ▶ **to text (someone)** to send a message to someone's mobile (UK)/cell (US) phone

▶ a birthday card



▶ an envelope



a stamp

an address

▶ a postcard

UK / US



Look at these differences between UK and US English.

UK

Amy **wrote to me** last week.
I'll **email** you with the dates.
Did you **post** the parcel?
I have a new **mobile/mobile phone**.
I'll give you a **ring** later.

US

Amy **wrote me** last week.
I'll **mail** you with the dates.
Did you **mail** the parcel?
I have a new **cell phone**.
I'll give you a **call**.* (= I'll phone you)

* Note that **call** is used in both UK and US English.
