

We use the **present simple** to talk about ...

- what we do every day:
*I **go** to school. My dad **drives** a taxi.*
- what we always / often / sometimes / never do:
*You **always get** up late on Sundays.*
*Katie **sometimes has** dinner at 6 o'clock.*

We use the **present continuous** to talk about ...

- what we are doing now:
*Jess **is sleeping**. We're **studying** English.*
