EXAMPLE SUBJECTS:



People (Characters),

1. IDENTIFICATION STAGE (INTRODUCTION)

- Introduce the subject to be described.
- Provide a **brief background**.

Example:

"I have a pet cat named Snowy."



Who?
What?

SUMMARY EXAMPLE TEXT:

Identification I have a pet cat named Snowy.

Description Snowy has soft white fur and blue eyes. He likes playing with a tennis ball.



2. DESCRIPTION STAGE (DETAIL)

- Describe the subject's characteristics in detail using the **five senses**.

A. PHYSICAL TRAITS (*Appearance*)
- height, color, shape

B. CHARACTERISTICS (*Personality*)
- friendly, smart, lazy

C. FEATURES (*Habits*)
- hobbies, home, preferences

"Snowy has soft white fur and blue eyes.
He likes playing with a tennis ball."



KEY LANGUAGE FEATURES

Use **SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE**
(V1, do/does/is/am/are)

Use **ADJECTIVES**
(Describing Words)

Use **NOUNS & NOUN PHRASES**
(People, Places, Things)



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
