An electromagnet consists of **an iron core/a plastic core** surrounded by coil of wire.


When the coil of **wire/iron** is connected to a source of electricity, like a battery, a **magnetic field/flow of energy** is created.

The iron becomes a **conductor/magnet** and attracts objects made of **insulating materials/magnetic metals**.

When there is no flow of electric current, electromagnets lose their **magnetism/electrical energy**.

This means they can be turned on and off by switching the **magnet/source of electricity** on or off.
