The decline of the Roman Empire has long intrigued historians, who argue that a complex combination of internal and external factors led to its collapse. Within the empire, political instability weakened central authority. Many emperors ruled for only brief periods, creating confusion and frequent struggles for power. Corruption and poor leadership reduced public confidence, while heavy taxation and the widespread use of slave labor slowed economic innovation. These problems discouraged citizens from taking part in government and trade. As trust in the state declined, the army also became less disciplined and loyal, leaving Rome increasingly vulnerable.

External pressures further accelerated the empire's decline. Invasions by Germanic tribes such as the Visigoths and Vandals placed enormous strain on Roman defenses. In 410 CE, the Visigoths famously sacked Rome, destroying parts of the city and shocking the ancient world. The Western Empire eventually fell in 476 CE, marking the end of Roman rule in Western Europe. However, the Eastern Empire, known as Byzantium, continued to prosper for another thousand years. The fall of Rome demonstrates that even the most powerful civilizations can deteriorate gradually through a combination of political weakness, economic decline, and repeated military challenges rather than a single catastrophic event.
