

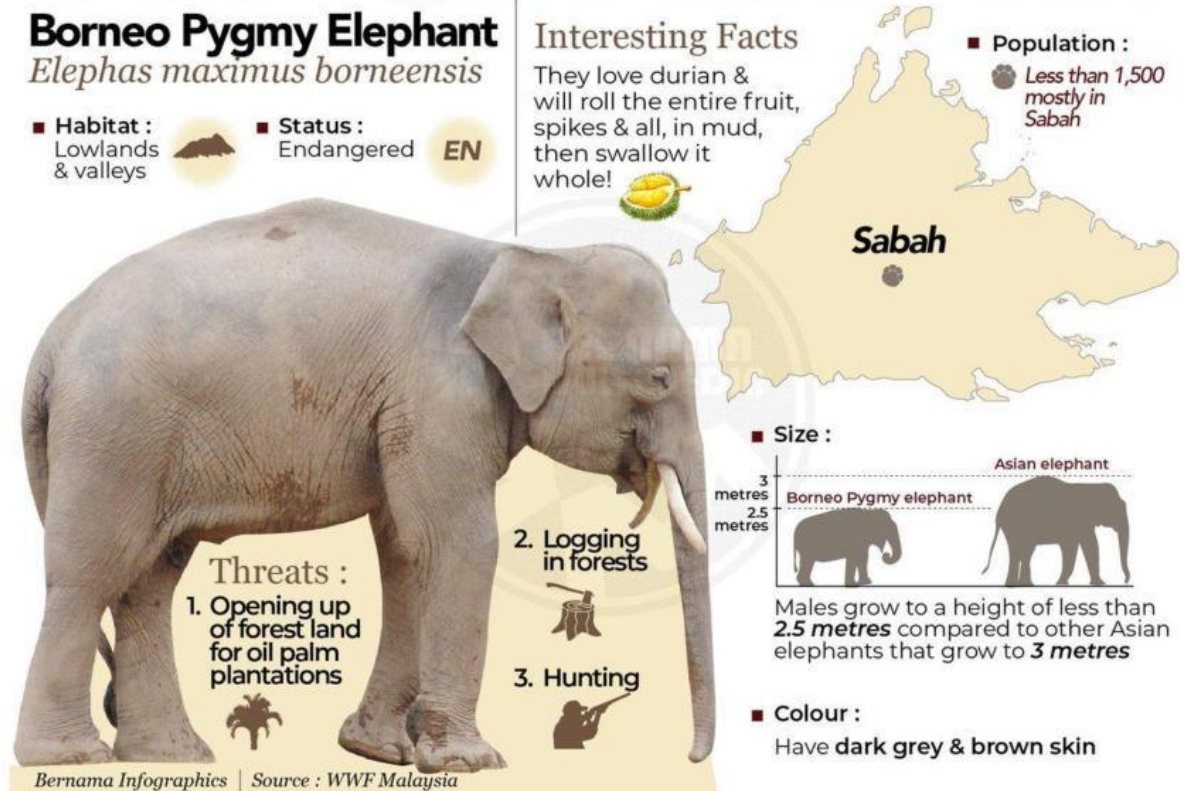

The Gentle Sea Cow

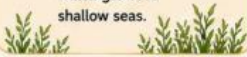
HABITAT

Lives in shallow coastal waters around Indonesia, including seagrass meadows in Southeast Asia.



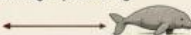
DIET

Herbivore. Eats seagrass, which grows in shallow seas.



PHYSICAL FEATURES

- Large, gray body with smooth skin.
- Flippers for swimming and a paddle-shaped tail.
- Can grow up to 3 meters long and weigh up to 420 kg.



THREATS

- Seagrass habitat loss
- Boat strikes
- Bycatch in fishing nets
- Marine pollution



CONSERVATION STATUS

VULNERABLE
(IUCN Red List)

Dugongs are in danger due to the loss of seagrass beds and human activities.



HOW CAN WE HELP?

- Protect seagrass beds and coastal habitats.
- Reduce plastic use.
- Support marine conservation and organizations.
- Be a responsible ocean lover!



FUN FACT!

Dugongs are often called "sea cows" because they graze on seagrass!



BEHAVIOR

- Gentle and slow-moving.
- Usually seen alone or in pairs.
- Surfacing to breathe every 3-5 minutes.
