I. OBJECTIVE

OA3: Utilizar su conocimiento del inglés en la comprensión y producción de textos orales y escritos claros, con el fin de construir una postura personal crítica en contextos relacionados con sus intereses e inquietudes.

Evaluation Objective: write a clear and organized opinion essay in English about the possible use of a futuristic job or technology in our agricultural school, expressing and supporting your personal point of view through formal language, opinion expressions, connectors and modal verbs.

II. SKILLS TO DEVELOP

During this evaluation, you will develop the following skills:

WRITING

Produce a clear and organized text in English.

CRITICAL THINKING

Express and defend your own opinion about a real situation.

ORGANIZATION

Connect ideas using appropriate connectors.

LANGUAGE USE

Use modal verbs and formal expressions to communicate your ideas.

PROBLEM SOLVING

Imagine how a future job or technology could solve a real need in an agricultural school.

III. CONTEXT: OUR AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL



Imagine that it is the year **2035**.

Our agricultural school has continued to develop. The school has agricultural areas, fruit trees, greenhouses, animals and different spaces where students learn through practical activities.

However, agriculture is changing.

There may be problems related to:

- water consumption
- climate change
- irrigation
- animal care
- crop monitoring
- food production
- waste management
- lack of time and human resources
- the need for new technological skills

For this reason, the school wants to imagine **new jobs that could exist in the future**.

Your challenge is to think like a future agricultural professional.

IV. YOUR CHALLENGE

Imagine a **FUTURE JOB** for Liceo Rafael Lira Infante.

Think about a job that could be useful **inside our school**.

Your future job must:

1. Be related to agriculture and/or technology.
2. Solve a real problem or need in the school.
3. Have a specific place where it could work.
4. Have specific responsibilities.
5. Be useful for students, animals, crops or the environment.

Possible examples:

Future Agricultural Technology Specialist

Could work in the **greenhouse** and use sensors to monitor temperature, humidity and plant growth.

Smart Irrigation Technician

Could work in the **school's agricultural fields** and use technology to control water consumption.



Animal Health Technology Assistant

Could work in the **animal areas** and use digital systems to monitor animal health.

Agricultural Drone Operator

Could monitor **fruit trees or agricultural areas** and identify problems in crops.

Hydroponic Production Technician

Could work in the **greenhouse** and control water, nutrients and plant growth.

VIII. CONNECTORS

Use at least 5 connectors.

To give reasons

because – since – as

To add ideas

also – moreover – in addition

To contrast

however – nevertheless – on the other hand



To show a result

therefore – as a result – for this reason

Examples:

Technology can save water **because** sensors can monitor irrigation.

However, technology cannot replace every agricultural worker.

The system can detect problems early; **therefore**, production could improve.

X. ORGANIZE YOUR IDEAS

Your essay must have **4 paragraphs**.

PARAGRAPH 1 – INTRODUCTION + OPINION

Introduce your future job and clearly state your opinion.

PARAGRAPH 2 – ARGUMENT 1

Explain what the person would do and where they would work.

PARAGRAPH 3 – ARGUMENT 2

Explain why this job would be useful for the school.

PARAGRAPH 4 – CONCLUSION

Summarize your opinion and give a final idea.

- include arguments supporting your opinion.
