Samsung offers many different products, including smartphones, televisions, home appliances, and semiconductors. **To reach customers with different needs, the company has provided a wide range of products.** Samsung also continues to develop new technologies to remain competitive in a rapidly changing market.

For a technology company to be successful, it needs to understand its customers and adapt to changes. Samsung continues to invest in areas such as artificial intelligence and advanced technologies in order to prepare for the future.

GRAMMAR: DESCRIBING PURPOSE

We use purpose clauses to explain why someone does something or why something is done. They answer: Why? / What is the purpose?

1. TO + INFINITIVE

Use to + base verb to explain the purpose of an action.

Structure: Subject + verb + to + infinitive

Examples:

- Samsung invests in technology to create new products.
- Companies advertise online to attract new customers.

2. IN ORDER TO + INFINITIVE

We can use in order to + verb to express purpose. It has the same basic meaning as to, but it can sound more formal or emphasize the purpose.

Examples:

- Samsung invests in research in order to develop new technologies.
- The company changed its design in order to attract younger customers.

3. FOR + NOUN + TO + INFINITIVE

We can use for + person/thing + to + verb. This structure explains the purpose or necessary condition for someone or something to do something.

Examples:

- For a company to be successful, it needs good leadership.
- For a product to succeed, it has to be useful.
