"Find the correct locker. The password has three parts."

Emma looked at the lockers. They were numbered from 1 to 20. She remembered that her teacher had given her three clues.

Clue 2: The first letter of the password is the 5th letter of the alphabet.

Clue 3: The colour of the locker is the colour of the sky on a clear day.

She entered 14 - E - BLUE as the password. The locker opened, and inside she found a small red notebook and a card.
