

HAVE / HAS VS. THERE IS / THERE ARE

HAVE / HAS

Meaning: **Ownership** (Ai có gì?)

Question: **Who has...?**

HAVE	HAS
I, You, We, They	He, She, It

EXAMPLES



I **have** a book.



She **has** a cat.

- +** S + **have/has** + noun.
- S + **don't/doesn't have** + noun.
- ?** **Do/Does** + S + **have** + noun?

SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, I/we/you/they **do**.
Yes, he/she/it **does**.
No, I/we/you/they **don't**.
No, he/she/it **doesn't**.

THERE IS / THERE ARE

Meaning: **Existence** (Có gì ở đâu?)

Question: **What/Who is there?**

THERE IS	THERE ARE
→ singular noun uncountable noun	→ plural noun
 a cat	 some milk
	 three books

EXAMPLES



There is a flower
on the table.



There are three children
in the park.

- +** There is + a/an + singular noun.
There are + plural noun.
 - There isn't + a/an + singular noun.
There aren't + plural noun.
 - ?** **Is there** + a/an + singular noun?
Are there + plural noun?
- SHORT ANSWERS**
Yes, there is. / No, there **isn't**.
Yes, there are. / No, there **aren't**.

REMEMBER!

HAVE / HAS

Someone has something.



Tom **has** a dog.

THERE IS / THERE ARE

Something exists somewhere.



There **is** a dog in the garden.



EASY TRICK!

Who has it? → USE **HAVE / HAS**

What is there? → USE **THERE IS / THERE ARE**
