GRAMMAR BOX

Form	Structure	Example
✓ Affirmative	S + am/is/are + V-ing	I'm meeting my cousin on Saturday.
✗ Negative	S + am/is/are + not + V-ing	She isn't coming tomorrow.
? Question	Am/Is/Are + S + V-ing?	Are you travelling next weekend?

Remember!

We use the Present Continuous to talk about **future plans** or **arrangements**.
We usually use future time expressions, for example:



• tomorrow



• tonight



• this evening



• next week



• next month



• on Saturday



• at 7 p.m.
