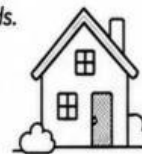

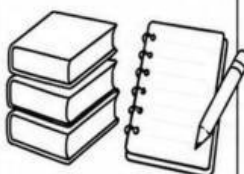
- Example 1: *This is because I have an important test next week.*
