- **Regular (+ed):** lived, started, visited
- **Irregular:** is → was / are → were, create → created



Example: "In 1965, Canada adopted its new flag."

2. Zero Conditional (General Truths)

Use this to state real facts and habits:

If / When + Present Simple, Present Simple

Example: "If you visit New Zealand, people say 'Kia Ora!'"
