Alex is 14 years old. He’s American, but his mother is Colombian, and His father is Argentinian. They live in U.S. **His/her Phone number is:** three – ten – oh, seven ..., his/ her **email address is:** ale hypen oh one at dmail dot com (ale-01@dmail.com).
