Job	What do they do?	Where do they work?
Accountant	Looks after the finances in an organisation.	an office.
Baker	Bakes bread.	a bakery.
Barber	Shaves men's beards and cut men's hair.	At the barber' s/barbershop (AmE).
Barman/woman	Serves drinks.	a bar, pub or restaurant.
Butcher	Prepares and sells meat.	At a butcher' s shop
Chambermaid	Cleans and tidies rooms.	a hotel.
Chef	Prepares and cooks food.	a kitchen.
Dentist	Looks after people's teeth.	a dentist.
Doctor	Looks after people's health.	a hospital or surgery.
Fishmonger	Prepares and sells fish.	At a fishmonger' s.
Flight attendant	Looks after passengers.	an airplane.
Hair dresser	Cuts and styles people's hair.	In a hair salon.
Judge	Judges and sentences people.	a law court.
Lawyer	Defends and prosecutes people.	a law court and in a lawyer' s office.
Nurse	Looks after patients .	a hospital or doctor's surgery.
Optician	Looks after people's eye sight.	an optician' s.
Porter	Carries other people's bags and luggage.	a hotel or train station.

Receptionist	Meets and greets visitors.	a reception desk
Sales Assistant	Sells goods and looks after customers.	a shop.
Secretary	Arranges appointments, types letters and organises meetings.	an office.
Surgeon	Operates on people who are sick.	a hospital.
Tailor	Designs, makes, alters or repairs garments,	factories and shops.
Teacher	Teaches people.	a school.
Technician	Organises and repair technical equipment.	everywhere!
Vet	Looks after people's animals.	a veterinary surgery or vet' s.
Waiter/Waitress	Serves people food and drink.	a restaurant.
Welder	Welds (= soude) metal to make things.	factories and construction sites.
