Grammar Focus

A tag question is a short question at the end of a sentence.

Positive sentence → Negative tag

S + am/is/are ..., + negative tag?

- He is happy, **isn't he?**
- They **are** ready, **aren't they?**
- You **are** a student, **aren't you?**

Negative sentence → Positive tag

S + am/is/are not ..., + positive tag?

- She **isn't** tired, **is she?**
- They **aren't** late, **are they?**

Special form

I am late, **aren't I?**
