

[BÀI 7] TAG QUESTIONS – PAST SIMPLE

Grammar Focus

1. Past Simple with TO BE

Positive sentence → Negative tag

S + was/were ..., wasn't/weren't + pronoun?

- Tom was at the stadium, **wasn't he?**
- They were tired, **weren't they?**

Negative sentence → Positive tag

S + wasn't/weren't ..., was/were + pronoun?

- She wasn't late, **was she?**
- They weren't tired, **were they?**

2. Past Simple with OTHER VERBS

Positive sentence → Negative tag

S + V2/ed ..., didn't + pronoun?

- She won the race, **didn't she?**
- They played football, **didn't they?**

Negative sentence → Positive tag

S + didn't + V0 ..., did + pronoun?

- He didn't play tennis, **did he?**
- They didn't win the match, **did they?**

Negative sentence → Positive tag

was →

wasn't

were →

weren't

V2/ed →

didn't

didn't + V0 →

did
