Relative Pronouns, like other pronouns, refer to somebody or something that has already been mentioned. At the same time, they join clauses together—relative clauses.

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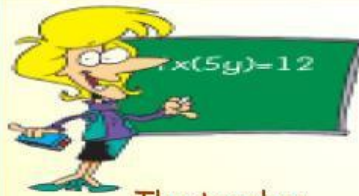
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
