



IMPORTANT RULES OF SINGULAR AND PLURAL NOUNS



- 1** Add **-s** to make most nouns plural.

Singular	Plural
book 	books
pen 	pens
chair 	chairs

- 2** Add **-es** to nouns ending in **s, ss, sh, ch, x, z**.

Singular	Plural
bus 	buses
class 	classes
brush 	brushes
watch 	watches
box 	boxes

- 3** Nouns ending in **y**
- If a consonant comes before y, change y to i and add **-es**.
 - If a vowel comes before y, just add **-s**.

Singular	Plural
baby 	babies
city 	cities
toy 	toys
key 	keys

- 4** Nouns ending in **f** or **fe**
Change **f/fe** to **ves**.

Singular	Plural
leaf 	leaves
wolf 	wolves
knife 	knives
wife 	wives

- 5** Nouns ending in **o**
Some take **-es**, some take only **-s**.

Singular	Plural
potato 	potatoes
tomato 	tomatoes
hero 	heroes
piano 	pianos
photo 	photos

- 6** Irregular Plurals
These do not follow a rule.

Singular	Plural
man 	men
woman 	women
child 	children
tooth 	teeth
foot 	feet
mouse 	mice
goose 	geese

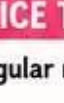
- 7** Same Form in Singular and Plural

Singular	Plural
sheep 	sheep
deer 	deer
fish 	fish

- 8** Compound Nouns
Add **-s** to the main word.

Singular	Plural
passer-by 	passers-by
mother-in-law 	mothers-in-law
brother-in-law 	brothers-in-law

- 9** Nouns Always Used in Plural Form

- scissors 
- trousers 
- spectacles 
- jeans 
- shorts 

- 10** Uncountable Nouns
Have No Plural Form

- water 
- milk 
- rice 
- sugar 
- furniture 
- information 

QUICK TIPS

- One = Singular
(one book, one child)
- More than one = Plural
(two books, three children)
- Always check for irregular plurals because they do not follow common rules.

Singular to Plural Nouns

RULE 1: ADD -ES

We add **-es** to most singular nouns ending in **s, ss, sh, ch, x, or o**.

Examples:

- bus → buses
- watch → watches

RULE 3: CHANGE Y TO IES

If a noun ends in a consonant + **y**, change **y** to **ies**.

Examples:

- baby → babies
- city → cities

RULE 2: CHANGE F OR FE TO VES

Some nouns ending in **f** or **fe** change **f** or **fe** to **ves**.

Examples:

- leaf → leaves
- knife → knives

RULE 4: NO CHANGE

Some nouns do not change in plural form. They are the **same** in singular and plural.

Examples:

- deer → deer
- sheep → sheep

PLURAL NOUNS

A plural noun is a word that names more than one person, place, thing, or idea.

1. RULES

Most nouns	Add -s. book → books	
Nouns ending in -s, -sh, -ch, -x, -z	Add -es. box → boxes watch → watches	
Nouns ending in a consonant + y	Change y to i and add -es. baby → babies	
Nouns ending in a vowel + y	Add -s. boy → boys	
Irregular nouns	The plural form changes. tooth → teeth
