Grammar first: Which tense do I need?

Present Perfect → things you have done or experienced during your holiday.

Past Simple → a finished action at a finished time.

Present Simple → facts and feelings about your holiday now.

Talk about...	Useful question	Tense
 Your holiday now	Where are you? How long have you been there?	Present Perfect
 Your experiences	What have you done? Who have you met?	Present Perfect
 A particular day	What did you do yesterday?	Past Simple
 Your feelings	How do you like it?	Present Simple
