mortgage

a calculation of someone's ability to pay back money that they have borrowed

investment

an amount of money that is borrowed, often from a bank, and has to be paid back, usually together with an extra amount of money that you have to pay as a charge for borrowing:

credit rating

the act of putting money, effort, time, etc. into something to make a profit or get an advantage, or the money, effort, time, etc. used to do this:

ATM

the activity of buying and selling shares in particular companies, and the people and organizations involved in this:

Stock market

an agreement that allows you to borrow money from a bank or similar organization, especially in order to buy a house, or the amount of money itself:

(spending) spree

abbreviation for **automated teller machine**: a machine, usually in a wall outside a bank, shop, etc. from which you can take money out of your bank account using a special card:

loan

a short period of doing a particular, usually enjoyable, activity much more than is usual:
