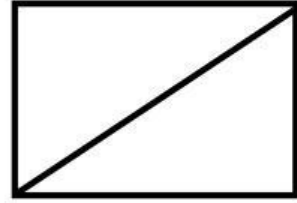

Home Learning Guide: Prepositions of Position

Hello Students and Parents! Since we are staying safe at home due to the current air quality in Brunei, let us use this time to review our English grammar together. This short reading guide covers prepositions of position using examples from our textbook.

What is a Preposition of Position?

Prepositions are little words that tell us where something or someone is located.

The Four Key Prepositions:

At: Used to show someone or something is close to a specific point.
Example: The cat is at the door.

Near: Used to show something is close by, but not right next to it.
Example: The tree is near the house.

Between: Used when something is in the middle of two other things.
Example: The table is between the chairs.

Beside: Used to show something is right next to something else.
Example: The car is beside the truck.

EXAMPLES:

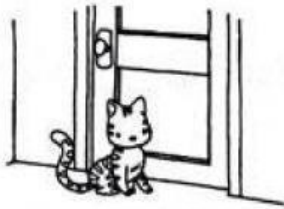
"The book is beside the lamp" or "The sofa is near the window".

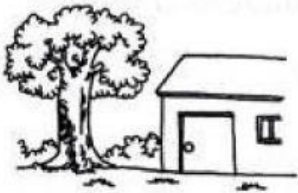

These are **prepositions** showing **position**:

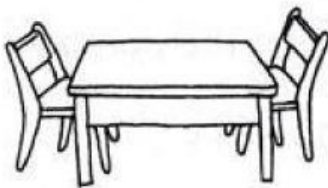
at, near, between, beside
