Komodo Dragon

Paragraf 1: The Komodo dragon (*Varanus komodoensis*) is the largest living species of lizard in the world. It can be found on several Indonesian islands, including Komodo, Rinca, Flores, and Gili Motang.

Paragraf 2: Komodo dragons grow up to three meters long, weigh up to seventy kilograms, and feature thick scaly skin, sharp claws, and a forked tongue used for smelling. As carnivorous animals, they hunt deer, wild boar, and water buffalo using their strong sense of smell and venomous bite.

Paragraf 3: Komodo dragons usually live alone and are most active during the day. They are excellent swimmers and can also climb trees when they are young. Because of their limited habitat, Komodo dragons are now classified as an endangered species and are protected by Indonesian law.
