

Shall and will

Drag and drop the information in the correct place.

I **will** call you tomorrow. We **shall** overcome this. **Will** you help me? (Request)

Shall we dance? (Formal suggestion) Expresses an expectation or future action.

Indicates a **strict obligation** . General future, spontaneous decisions, promises, and predictions.

Formal suggestions, offers, and legal obligations. Standard in modern English (spoken and written).

Rare in American English; limited to formal British English. Used with all pronouns (**I, you, he, she, it, we, they**). Mostly used with **I** and **We** (in questions and offers).

Neutral, informal, or conversational. Highly formal, elegant, or official.
