Hi! My name's Ben and I'm 9 years old. There are many useful machines in my home.



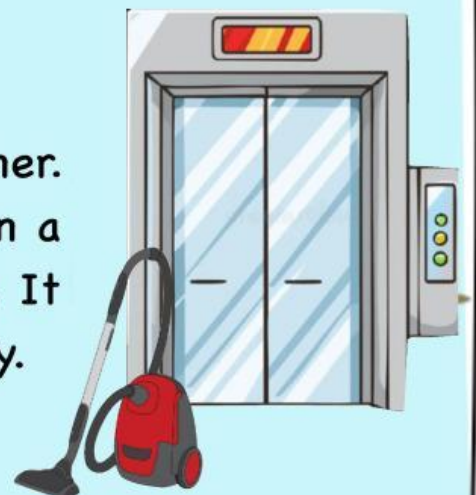
In the living room, we have a big TV. My brother and I watch cartoons on it after school. There's also a camera on the table. My dad uses it to take photos when we go on holiday.
