Coordinates are written (latitude, longitude). Example: (39, -77) means 39° north and 77° west.

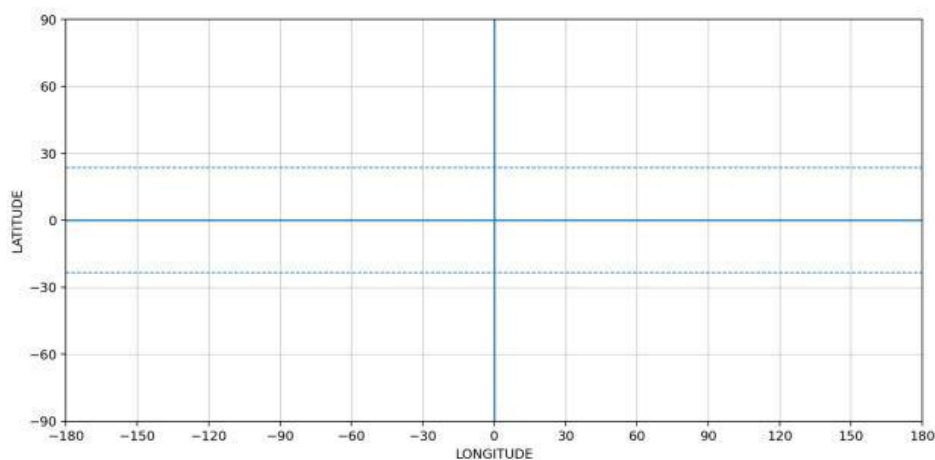
Label the Equator, Prime Meridian, Tropic of Cancer, and Tropic of Capricorn. The Tropics are at about 23.5° north and south.

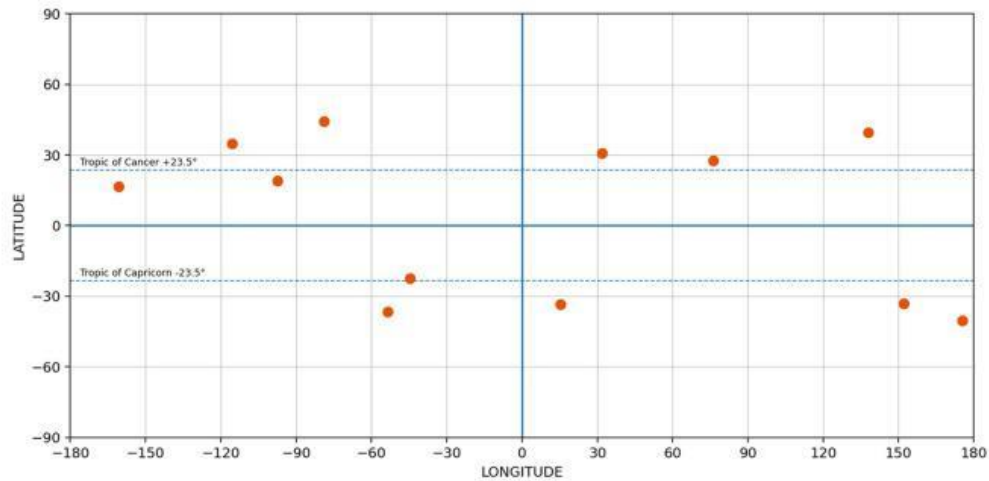

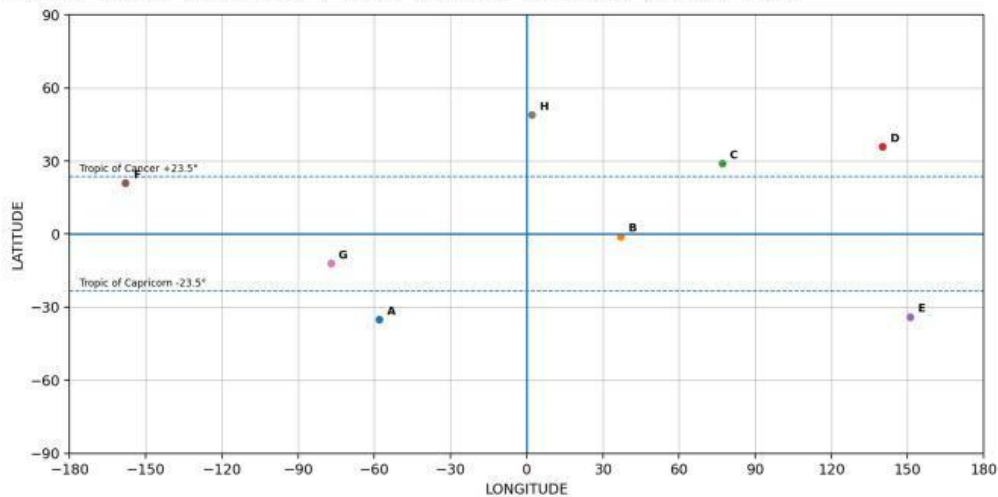
