Can't have + V3	Suy đoán có căn cứ về một sự việc không thể nào / chắc chắn đã không xảy ra trong quá khứ.	<i>Alex was in London yesterday, so you can't have seen him in Hanoi all day.</i>
Might have + V3	Suy đoán về một việc có thể đã xảy ra trong quá khứ nhưng không chắc chắn .	<i>Nam didn't come to class today. He might have missed the school bus.</i>
