Usage Summary

WILL:

- **Rapid decisions:** Decisions made at the exact moment of speaking.
- **Offers:** Offering help or doing a favor.
- **Threats:** Threats or warnings.
- **Promises:** Making promises.
- **Predictions (personal opinion):** Predictions based on personal beliefs or thoughts (often used with *I think, in my opinion, I believe*).

BE GOING TO:

- **Predictions (evidence):** Predictions based on clear, present evidence in the situation.
- **Plans and intentions:** Plans or intentions decided before the moment of speaking.
