We use the Simple Present Interrogative to **ask** about routines, habits, facts, and everyday activities.

To make questions in the Simple Present, we use the **auxiliary verbs** **do** and **does**.

DO

Use with: I / You / We / They

DO + subject + base verb + complement?

- **Do** you like pizza?
- **Do** they study English?

DOES

Use with: He / She / it

DOES + subject + base verb + complement?

- **Does** she play games?
- **Does** he have a dog?

Remember: After does, the main verb stays in the base form.

✓ **Does** she like music? →

✗ **Does** she likes music?

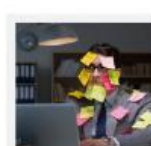
