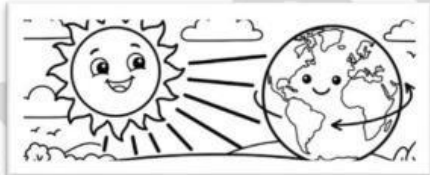


THE PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE

1. Usage

Daily routines	  He wakes up everyday. He goes to school at 9 a.m
General facts	 The Sun rises the Earth.
Timetables and schedules	

2. Forms

2.1 Affirmative

Subject	Verb
I / You / We / They	V
He / She / It	V (s,es)



I go to school everyday.



Mom works at the office.

2.2 Negative

Subject + do/does not + base verb

Example:

- I do not like coffee.
- He does not watch TV at night.



2.3 Yes/No questions

Do/does not + subject + base verb

Example:

- Do you play football?
- Does she live near here?



3. Adverb of frequency



Example: *I usually get up at 6 a.m.*

4. Common mistakes

- ✗ She go to school every day.
✓ She **goes** to school every day.



- ✗ Does he **likes** music?
✓ Does he **like** music?
