

PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE

I. WHAT IS THE PRESENT SIMPLE?

We use the **Present Simple** to talk about:

Use	Example
Daily routines	I go to school every day.
General facts	Water boils at 100°C.
Timetable & Schedules	The class starts at 7 a.m.



get up



go to school



time



schedule

★ **Remember:** The Present Simple is often used with expressions such as **everyday, often, usually,...**

II. FORM

1. Affirmative (+) & Negative (-)

Affirmative (+)	Negative (-)
I / You / We / They + V	I / We / You / They + don't + V
He / She / It + V (-s/es)	He / She / It + doesn't + V

Example:

- I **go** to school every day.
- She **works** in an office.
- I **do not like** coffee.
- He **does not watch** TV at night.



go to school



works in office

★ **Remember:**

With he / she / it, the main verb usually + -s / es

After do not (don't) / does not (doesn't), use the base verb



do not like



does not watch

2. Yes / No question

Do/Does + subject + base verb?

Examples:

- Do you play football?
- Does she live near here?



III. ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

Adverb	Meaning
always	luôn luôn
usually	thường
sometimes	thỉnh thoảng
never	không bao giờ

Example: I **usually** get up at 6 a.m.



never → always
