• Form

1. Affirmative

Subject	Verb
I / You / We / They	work / study / play
He / She / It	works / studies / plays

Example:

à I **go** to school everyday.

à She **works** in a shopping mall.

2. Negative

Subject + do/does not + base verb



He **does not** like coffee

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She **does not** like cooking at home

3. Yes/No Questions

Do/Does + subject + base verb?

Example:



here?

Yes, she does

• Adverbs of frequency

Adverb of Frequency	Meaning	Example Sentence
Always	100% of the time	She always comes on time.
Usually	90% of the time	We usually walk to school.
Often	70-80% of the time	He often helps his friends.
Sometimes	50% of the time	They sometimes play football.
Rarely / Seldom	10-20% of the time	She rarely eats sweets.
Never	0% of the time	He never tells lies.
