Tense	Past perfect	Past perfect progressive
From	S + had + P.P (V3)	S + had +been + P.P (V3)
Example	The train had just left when I arrived at the station.	She had been working for the company for three years when it went out of business.
Time expression	just, before, ever, never, until then, already, yet	for, since, all morning, all day.
