

Reported speech (requests and orders)

- **tell(s) + someone + to do something**
- **ask(s) + someone + to do something (kui lauses on sõna “please”)**
- **ära unusta, et asesõnad muutuvad kaudses kõnes**

For example

1. “Stop running in the street,” the policeman says to the kids.

The policeman **tells kids to** stop running in the street.

2. Father says to me, “Close the window, please.”

Father **asks me to** close the window.

3. “Clean **your** room and wash **your** dishes,” mum says to me.

Mum **tells me to** clean **my** room and wash **my** dishes.

- 9) „Please open your books at page thirty,“ the Math teacher says to the students.
- 10) „Read the instructions carefully before you do your test,“ the Driving School teacher says to us.
