1. GEOMETRIC SHAPES

Geometric shapes have regular forms and are often made using lines, curves, or mathematical patterns.

Examples:



Circle



Square



Triangle



Rectangle



Oval



Hexagon



Diamond

Think about:

buildings, windows, wheels, clocks, signs, and tiles. These often contain geometric shapes.

Example:

A **window** may look like a rectangle.

A **clock face** may look like a circle.



2. ORGANIC SHAPES

Organic shapes are usually irregular, natural-looking shapes. They often resemble things found in nature.

Examples:



Leaf shapes



Cloud shapes



Flower shapes



Shell shapes



Waves



Tree forms

Organic shapes do not usually have perfectly straight sides or exact measurements.

Think about:

plants, animals, clouds, rocks, water, and other things in nature.



3. ABSTRACT SHAPES

Abstract shapes are shapes that may not clearly represent a specific real-life object. They can be unusual, imaginative, simplified, or created from combinations of shapes and lines.

Examples:



Wavy forms



Jagged forms



Swirling forms



Unusual combinations



Imaginative forms

Abstract shapes are often used to express **ideas, feelings, movement, or imagination.**
