GRAMMAR BOX

HAVE GOT

I have got a cat.
You have got a dog.
He / She has got a fish.
We have got a rabbit.
They have got a turtle.

★ Short form: I've got, you've got, he's got, we've got, they've got.

CAN (ABILITY)

Birds can fly.
Fish can swim.
Dogs can run.
Rabbits can jump.

★ Use can + base verb to talk about abilities.

LIKE

I like cats.
You like dogs.
He / She likes birds.
We like fish.
They like turtles.

★ Use like + noun / -ing.

PRESENT SIMPLE

Affirmative (+)

I like cats.
You like cats.
He likes cats.
She likes cats.
We like cats.
They like cats.

★ Add -s / -es for he, she, it.

Negative (-)

I don't like snakes.
You don't like snakes.
He doesn't like snakes.
She doesn't like snakes.
We don't like snakes.
They don't like snakes.
